POLYMER: IF YOU ARE UNABLE TO WATER YOUR TREES
BE SURE TO READ THIS

Polymer greatly improves survival where people are unable to water their trees. The polymer is granular and when added to water, absorbs up to 400 times its weight. It enables seedlings to survive temporary moisture stress. This is important to those whose plantings will not receive supplemental water or where there is no water supply on the site. Available in ½ and 1 pound bags. A ½ lb bag will do about 60 trees.

RABBIT GUARDS & BAMBOO STAKES

The rabbit guards are a plastic mesh tube (diamond mesh pattern), which is placed over a seedling to protect it from rabbits and other animals. The guards are photodegradable in a 3-year period. The guards are 18” long and 4” diameter. Bamboo stakes may be used to anchor the guard around the seedling.

WEED BARRIER FABRIC
(Advance order requested)

We highly recommend this accessory for your most successful planting. In the past, weed barrier has increased survival rate from 35% up to 90% or more. Weed Barrier is used to control weeds, protect against evaporation, to conserve soil moisture in tree plantings, and increase height and crown growth in seedling trees. It is a fabric made of woven polypropylene, which last a minimum of 5 years. It is available in rolls of 6’ x 300’; 6’ x 500’; 6’ x 750’; or 4’ x 4’ squares. Weed barrier rolls work best when laid by machine. Call 541-2359 x 101 for information regarding equipment to lay fabric.
