To be eligible all materials (trees, weed barrier, etc) must be purchased from Double El CD. Weed barrier fabric is required for all windbreak projects for cost share assistance. All windbreak designs must meet guidelines approved by the NRCS and the Conservation District. All costs will be paid for by the applicant. Reimbursement for approved cost share amount will be paid upon completion and approval by the NRCS and Conservation District. I also understand that I am responsible for making arrangements to have the windbreak completed by June 30, 2022. Windbreaks that have been installed <u>prior</u> to cost share application approval are <u>not</u> eligible for assistance.</p>
